The Assembly Area Map below indicates your assigned entry number and check-in location. Please bring your Map with you to simplify the check-in process. Check-in Time is 8:00 AM on Saturday, August 6th.

The Parade route is 1 mile long; going west on Main Street from Aliso Late at Cemetery Park to Pal Street. Once you receive your entry number it must be displayed on your right arm or the right side of your vehicle for ease of identification by the judges in the Assembly Area and on the Reviewing Stand. Pre-Parade judging will begin in the Assembly Area at 9:00 AM.

Our Assembly Area is on Main Street you must check in with the Marshals at Catalina and Main Street.

Buses and other vehicles will be required to unload in the designated assembly area and then leave the area immediately to minimize congestion. The assembly Areas will be restricted to Parade Participants only. The Parade will disband by proceeding down to the parking lots and park areas between Palm Street and the Museum to enter Santa Clara Street. Santa Clara Street will be close to vehicular traffic for at least one hour after the Parade to serve as the Dispersal Area.

No objects of any kind can be thrown or distributed to the viewing crowd on the sidelines for safety reasons. Parade Marshals will enforce these rules and encourage you to keep moving.

All Awards will be presented in the fair grandstand beginning at 2pm.
